Upon successful completion, you will receive credit for Level 1 of the Carpentry apprenticeship program. Carpenter is a nationally designated trade under the Interprovincial Red Seal program.

This ten month program is offered on a day 2 in a Vancouver high school.

- build concrete formwork

Building the framework

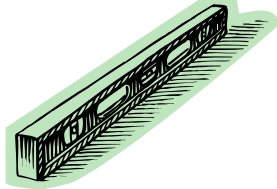
You must intend to complete all secondary school graduation requirements. As well you should have:

- Carpentry, Woodworking, Drafting courses (as many as possible)
- Applications of Math 11
- "L" drivers license

Do you have what it takes?

If you have the following as part of your personality, then you're already half way there!

- fluent in English (oral and written)
- dedication, commitment and maturity to further your desired career goals
- strong interest in the field of carpentry
- good dexterity and hand-eye coordination
- ability to work independently
- high physical fitness level
- comfortable working at various heights
- social and friendly, able to work with a team

**What do you accomplish?**

- complete Level 1 of the Carpentry Program which saves you \$2400 in tuition
- receive 20 credits towards graduation
- earn a Career Preparation Program Certificate in the focus area of Trades & Technology
- receive an additional 16 credits if enrolled in Secondary School Apprenticeship either during or at the completion of the ACE IT program

Having achieved all this you are now able to start your apprenticeship with a trades qualified carpenter.
