Upon successful completion, you will receive credit for Level 1 of the Plumbing apprenticeship program. Plumbing is a nationally designated trade under the Interprovincial Red Seal program.

This six week program, offered by the Piping Industry Apprenticeship Board takes places from June 23 to August 3, 2008. It will be held at the Annacis Island Training Centre located at: 1329 Cliveden Avenue, Delta BC (This is on a bus route).

- contractors (residential or commercial)
- maintenance departments

Remember, if you achieve your Interprovincial Red Seal, you can work anywhere in Canada.

The Task at Hand

- learn basic skills required by industry
- learn safe work practices
- read and interpret drawings and schematics
- introduction to water pipe and drainage systems
- acquire soldering techniques
- introduction to the Plumbing code

- Math 11

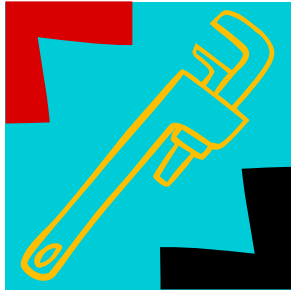
