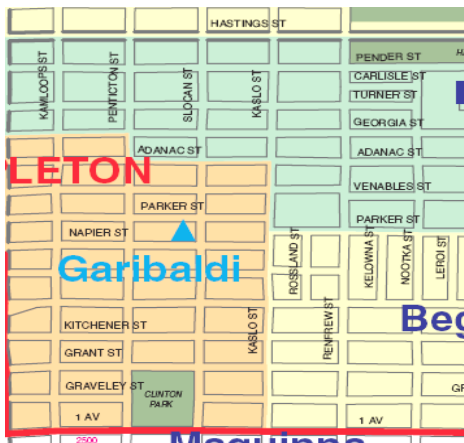


## Where is the Elementary VLN?

# What is the Elementary Vancouver Learning Network?

The Elementary VLN is a fully accredited B.C. public school of the Vancouver School Board. The teachers provide the British Columbia Ministry of Education curriculum to K to 7 students of B.C. residence wishing to study at home or abroad.

Among the many services provided to VLN students are:

- A full range of print-based curriculum materials in all subjects for all grades K to 7.
- Three district-approved report cards per school year
- Free tuition and free learning materials (refundable damage deposit required)
- Special resource teacher support for students with unique learning needs
- Access to modified and adapted programs for students learning above or below grade level
- Access to online web-based activities and resources
- Academic supervision, assessment, counseling and curriculum support
- Communication and support in person or by mail, telephone or email throughout the school year
- Regular field trips and social events organized for local students
- Technology assistance and training in our school computer lab
- Pre-paid envelopes for submitting assignments



# Who are the VLN Students?

The Elementary VLN serves a wide variety of students including:

- Students who choose to learn at home
- Students temporarily out-of-province or out-of-country, who wish to continue studying the B.C. elementary curriculum with the support of a certified B.C. teacher
- Students with health or personal issues that prevent attendance in a regular school setting
- Students in athletic and performing arts programs who require a flexible study schedule



# How do I register?

In order to register with the VLN the following items must be provided:

- A withdrawal note from the student's previous school (not required if registering in September)
- A \$100 refundable book deposit for each student (\$300 if temporarily out of B.C.)
- A recent report card
- A birth certificate or appropriate immigration documents
- Proof of B.C. residency (e.g. Hydro bill)
- A face-to-face meeting with the teacher to discuss and sign a student learning plan

**NEW!** Up to \$100 is available to subsidize participation in sports or music activities. Your teacher can provide you with details.
