This five month program will be offered 4 days a week at a VCC campus. The program begins in February.

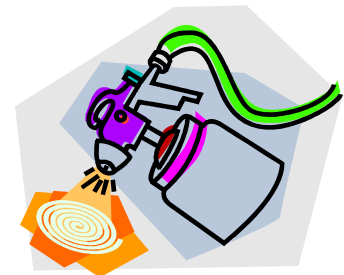
Employment opportunities

If you have the following assets, then you're already half way there!

- fluent in English (oral and written)
- strong automotive skills
- good general health and respiratory condition
- physical strength and stamina
- ability to tolerate noise and strong odours
- mechanical aptitude and interest

- Complete Level 1 of the Automotive Refinishing Prep Technician Program which will save you approximately \$1800 in tuition.
- Receive 20 credits towards graduation.
- Receive an additional 16 credits if enrolled in Secondary School Apprenticeship either during or at the completion of the ACE IT program.

Having achieved all this you are now able to start your apprenticeship with a trades qualified Automotive Refinishing Prep Technician.

What we've got for you!

Our program is designed especially for young minds like yours and offers skill development appropriate for today's industry standard. You'll take such courses as:

- Paint shop safety
- Tools and equipment
- Spray guns
- Air compressors
- Air transformers and hoses
- Spray booths, bake oven, heat lamps
- Surface preparation
- Masking
- Undercoats
- Topcoats
- Solvents
- Paint preparation and application (complete, blends and spot repair)

How to make it happen!

There are several steps to complete:

- You must meet with your counsellor and parent(s) to help plan the program.
- Once that's done, hand in your application package to your counsellor or the Career Centre. Application deadlines are listed on the VSB website.

After that, the District Career Programs staff at the VSB will review the application then get back to you for an interview that could allow you to get ready to embark on your first career!
