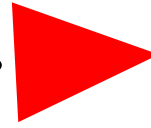

This one year program is offered at Vancouver Technical School - the longest-running hairdressing school in BC.

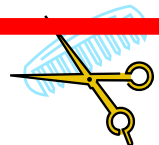
The ACE IT program includes 7 hairdressing classes and 240 hours of work-based training.
