Highlight of Architectural Heritage Elements The four brick buildings’ (A, B, C, D) architectural style is expressed in a Classical vocabulary and symmetrical elevations. The Primary and Senior Buildings are designed in a ‘Barbell Plan’, where there is a central linear spine with projecting wings at each end. The brick buildings have ornate Classical features such as pediment-like gables, cornices with dentils and friezes, stepped parapets, cupola, and vertical piers. Internal spaces include original hardware, integrated windows and high ceilings.
