

What is a 'Full' school?

- **Full School:**
 - A school that has inadequate physical space to accommodate in-catchment applicants.
- **13 full schools (14 sites – Roberts/Roberts Annex are one catchment)**
 - Carr, Cavell, Crosstown, Elsie Roy, False Creek, Fleming, Fraser, Gordon, Hudson, Lord, Nelson, Norma Rose Point, Roberts and Roberts Annex
- **75 other Elementary/Annex Schools**
 - The District will be working in the next month to determine preliminary staffing for all other Elementary Kindergarten schools
 - Kindergarten classes must be organized in accordance with Class Size and Composition Rules.
 - The District organizes kindergarten classes efficiently in cohort sizes of 18-20

Full School Process

Students placed on a waitlist at a Full school that require placement are offered a placement at a neighbouring school that has available space.

Full schools maintain ordered waitlists. Late applicants are added to the waitlist by time and date of application.

- When spots become available – students are offered those spots in waitlist order
- Waitlists are kept until exhausted
