Immigrant Parents as Literacy Supporters (1 on-site session & 7 virtual sessions)

Program for newcomers and immigrant families with children ages 3-5.
(For families with permanent resident status.)

The Vancouver School Board is offering a free family literacy program with 1 on-site & 7 virtual sessions that will give parents & caregivers strategies to encourage learning in their preschool aged children. Within IPALS, children learn to develop language and literacy abilities that will help them gain skills that prepare them for school. Great learning materials are provided to use at home. Program will be presented in English with translated materials in different languages.

LIMIT: 15 participants/families & they will be assigned to small groups for on-site session.

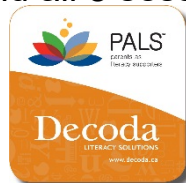
