Good morning StrongStart families,


Today's post is put together by Ms. Doris (from Selkirk) and Ms. Natalya (from Nightingale).

Ready for more frog fun? Let's sing "Five Green Speckled Frogs" with Ms. Natalya - <https://youtu.be/ZkpjxYxoha0>.

Next, we will make our own lily pad game. For this game, "Lily Pad Hop", you will need some green/white paper, stickers (optional), markers, scissors and painters' tape.

Directions

1. Cut out the lily pads (see photo below).
2. Write numbers 1-10 on the lily pads - one number per lily pad.
3. Optional - Add the correct number of stickers on each lily pad. For example, three stickers for the "3" lily pad.
4. Stick the lily pads to the floor using painters' tape and start hopping!
5. Try different ways of moving - hopping, tip-toeing, skipping, galloping or jumping backwards.
6. Try it with ABCs - instead of numbers, you can practice letter recognition with the upper and/or lower case alphabets.



If you don't have green paper, you can do another movement activity with painter's tape like Ms. Natalya - <https://youtu.be/xKg3nsRnlBw>.

I bet you are all tired out from hopping and jumping so let's sit down for a singing story, called "Froggie and Tadpole", with Ms. Doris - <https://youtu.be/R-ndyPpsdl>.
