Do you know what is a cat's favourite food? It's MICE Krispies! We've got two mouse-themed songs today. The first is Ms. Evina's fingerplay called "Creepy Mouse"

Instructions

- 2) Tie a piece of string or yarn to a hole.
- 3) Have the child lace through the holes.
