Cardboard Construction Set

- Cut rolls into different lengths. You can paint or colour them with markers.
- Cut small slots at the top and bottom of each. Make sure your slots are in the same position top and bottom by marking it with a ruler.

Holey Toilet Paper Threading

- Take a single hole puncher and punch holes into toilet paper roll.
- Use straws to thread through holes.

- Tape toilet paper rolls onto wall with painters' tape.
- Drop small balls or pom poms through the tubes.
