Colour Sorting

Materials - egg carton, markers to colour the spaces, pom poms or small coloured objects.



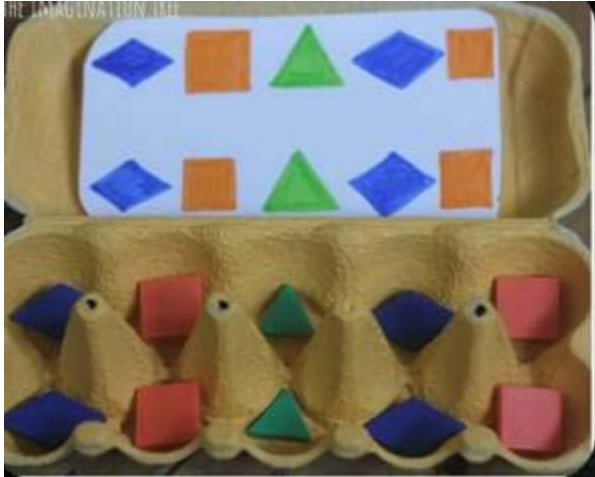
Counting Numbers

Like the first activity, instead of colours, you use numbers! If you don't have pom poms, you can use dried pasta, beads, or buttons.



Shapes and Patterns

Cut out basic shapes from paper and colour them. Draw a pattern for the children to replicate in the egg carton.



Alphabets

If you have any magnetic letters, you can write the letters on the egg carton and have the child put the magnetic letters into the corresponding spot.
