Next Wednesday is Canada Day so we have some special activities for you to do!

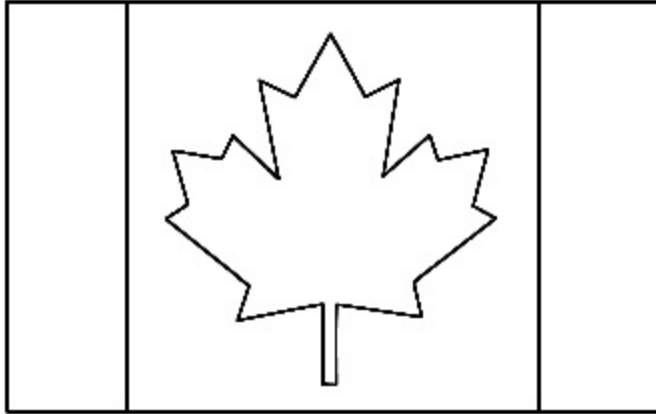


Streamer Wands (2 Ways):



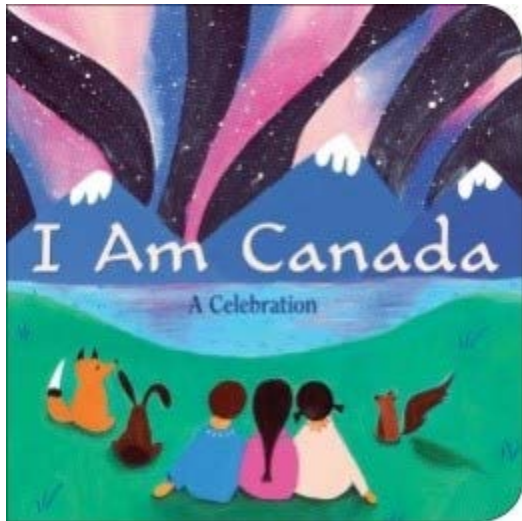
- Wrap strips of red and white coloured streamers/ribbons/crepe paper/construction paper to a dowel, stick, pencil or straw.
- Tape red and white streamers/ribbons to the end of a stick.

Decorate a Canada flag (3 ways)



- Color in the flag with markers, paint, bingo dabbers, crayons, pencil crayons, etc.
- Cut strips of red paper and have your child tear small pieces off the strip. Glue the pieces of paper onto the flag. Tearing paper is great for fine motor development!
- Make a collage by finding various red and white items (from flyers or magazines) to the flag.
