Yo te amo, yo te amo.

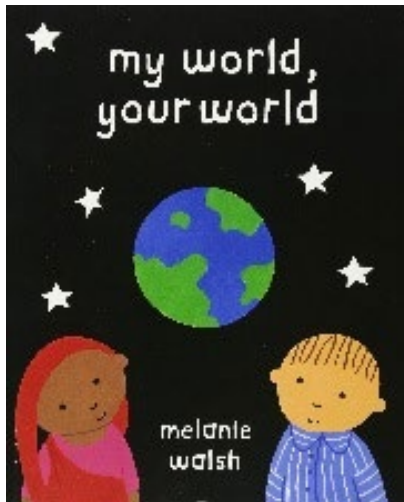
All day long, I sing this little song to you.

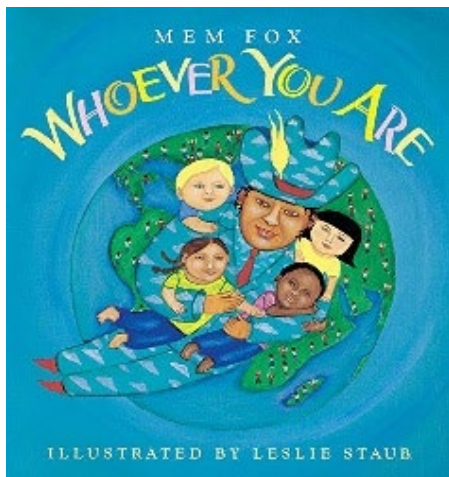
Darling, I love you.

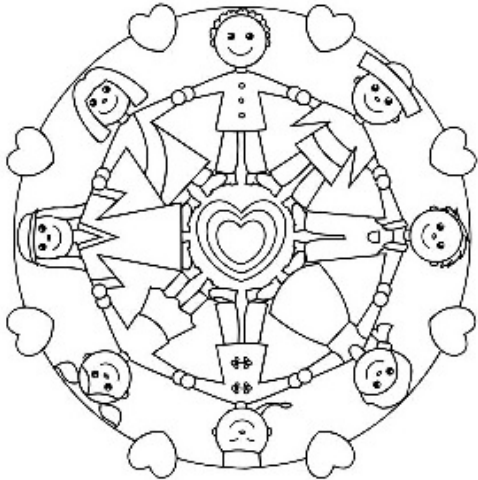

Materials

- 1 white egg
- 1 brown egg
- plate

Discussion

- Talk to your child about the two eggs. Do they look different?
- What is the main difference with the two eggs? Because they are different on the outside, do you think they are different on the inside?
- Let's find out! Crack the two eggs and see. Are they different? Nope, they are pretty much the same.
- To avoid food waste, let's cook the eggs and see if it tastes the same.
