Today's email is from Teacher Linda (from Grenfell).

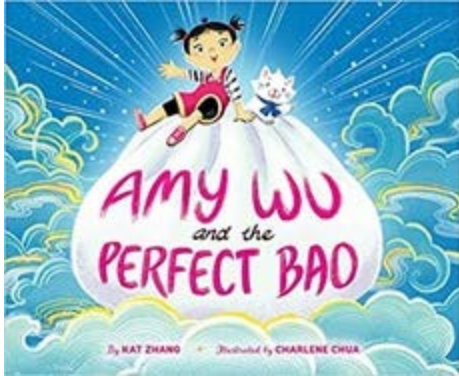


It's Family Literacy Week and we continue our focus on diverse books for children. Here are two more wonderful reads:

After reading the book, we need to gather our ingredients for some cooking.

Bao Dough: 1 packet of active dry yeast (2¼ tsp), ½ cup warm water, 4 cups of flour, 2 tsp baking powder, 2 tsp salt, 1/8 cup of sugar, 1 cup of low fat milk, 2 TBSP vegetable oil.

While you are waiting for your bao to cook, you can sing this song called "Baking a Bao Bun" (by Teacher Linda, to the tune "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush).
