Quarter 3 Final Report Card

Report Cards Posted to MyEducation BC on April 29, 2021 by 4:00 pm

Student progress will be reported using cumulative assessment, which means that the grade a student receives always reflects the student's most recent and updated progress. Report cards will include a grade, work habit and comment. Grade 10 to 12 courses will report student progress using percentages. Grade 8 & 9 student progress will be reported using the Proficiency Scale.

How to access your student's report card on the MyEducation BC Family Portal

Report cards can be found on the MyEd BC Family Portal. Please follow the instructions below to locate your child's report card:

1. Go to the MyEd Website (<https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/asp/en/logon.do>)
2. Type in the student number as the login ID
3. The password is the one that you and your student have already been using.
4. You will find the report card under "Published Reports" on the right-hand side.
5. **Please note** report cards are deleted when new reports are generated. You may wish to save a copy for your records.

1. Click on the "I forgot my password" link.
2. A response should come to the email that is associated with the account.

Quarter 4 Changes

Changes to the quarter 4 schedule begin **April 27, 2021** and the following adjustments will be made:

- Maximize the amount of in-person learning time to 2 hours and 45 minutes **every day** for grade 8 and 9 courses.
- Increase in-person learning time for students in grade 10, 11, and 12 courses to 2 hours and 45 minutes **2 days a week**.
- Any student wanting to attend school all day may do so but must complete the [All Day Instruction Request Form](#)
- Continue to work collaboratively with families to support those students struggling with their overall mental health and well-being.

Please note that there has been a slight change to the timing of the day's schedule to allow students to get to their next periods class. These times are highlighted in the schedules below.

Expectations for Quarter 4

- Students are **required to attend their classes as scheduled** (Group A or B) unless prior arrangements have been made by [filling out this form](#). Please review these expectations with your child.
 - Students will attend their scheduled classes as well as the morning or afternoon Group (this may increase class size to more than 15 students)
- Students in multi-grade 9-12 classes (e.g. Woodworking, Photography, Food Studies, etc.) will be scheduled as a grade 10-12 class (teachers will communicate class specific schedule)
- Linearly scheduled classes will continue to operate on the Linear Schedule. Classroom teachers will communicate class specific schedule.
- Students wanting to stay at school the entire day are permitted to do so:
 - Students are expected to be in a classroom working with a teacher or in one of the spaces listed below if they are staying at school.
 - The Resource Center will continue to be open to support students on IEPs or requiring additional learning support.
 - The library will continue to be open for computer use and quiet study.
 - The cafeteria will continue to be open for students on the lunch program and as a space for all students to eat but we ask that students leave the area once they are finished their meal.
- **Instruction will not be individualized for those students attending both morning and afternoon classes, this will be a repeat of instruction. We are asking families to complete the following form for students if they are wishing to attend full days: [Tupper Full Day Instruction](#)**

Health and Safety Reminders

At Tupper we continually review and reinforce our COVID-19 health and safety plans and procedures in consultation with VCH and VSB Health and Safety. We will also be taking time this week to review and reinforce health and safety protocols and procedures with all students for the start of Quarter 4. As always, we will ensure all COVID-19 health and safety measures are followed in everything we do.

Tupper staff have worked together to put in place protocols and practices that keep all students and staff safe. Currently, it is our collective responsibility to continue our efforts and ensure we all follow the guidelines that keep us safe:

- Maximize physical distancing.
- Minimize physical contact.
- Practice frequent and proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette.
- Wear masks as appropriate and required (in all common areas)

- Students should continue to use designated entrances (doors open 10 minutes before class starts)
- Students are not able to congregate, socialize, in common indoor areas.
