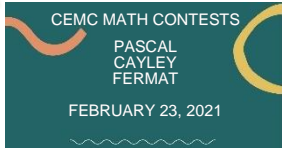

### **Winter Food Drive for USRO (February 19-29)**

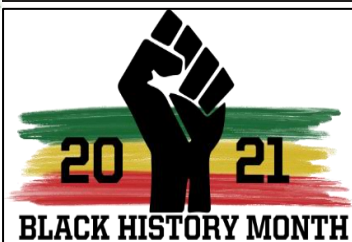

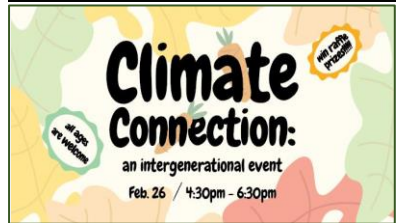

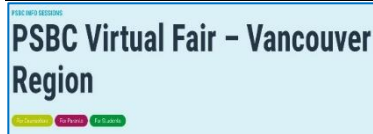
