I am writing to let you know that we have been made aware that a member of our school community has tested positive for COVID-19. The exposure occurred November 18, 19, and 20th.

It is important that you know that Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) has contacted any individuals who they have determined need to be informed because they were in the same class as the exposure. A letter has also been sent to these individuals from Vancouver Coastal Health.

If you have not been contacted by Vancouver Coastal Health, it is because they have determined you are not at risk and do not need to be concerned. As always if you have questions about COVID-19 please contact your health care provider, call 8-1-1 or see the Vancouver Coastal Health website (www.vch.ca).

I want to assure you that the safety and well-being of our students, families and staff remains our highest priority. Gladstone Secondary School will continue to implement strict health and safety protocols and procedures. The Vancouver School District works very closely with, and follows the guidance and direction of, Vancouver Coastal Health.

As a school and District, we are required by law to protect the personal privacy rights of individuals. As such, we are unable to provide any information beyond what has been shared in this email.

As the school year progresses it is normal for students and staff to be away from school from time to time due to illness, vacation, or family circumstance. I ask for your support in not speculating or commenting on such absences.
