Daily schedule

We have made slight updates to the daily schedule for Quarter 3 – though the start of the day and end of the day remain unchanged.

The daily schedule is now as follows:

Course Planning

Counsellors will be course planning for the school year beginning September 2021 with grade 8-11 students during the month of February.

Normally, counsellors would bring an entire class to the computer lab to do course planning with them in-person. Due to Covid protocols this is not possible this year. Instead, Course Planning will be done virtually on Teams.

Your child will be contacted by their counsellor on Teams to access on-line instructions, course descriptions, and videos for them to choose their courses for next year. You can also work with your child through this process.

While this is important for all students, it is especially important for students in **grades 11 and 12** as they carefully consider the requirements of the post-secondary institutions they may wish to attend. Requirements for different post-secondary institutions and different programs are different.

For example:

What courses do you require to enter the BCIT program in carpentry? Grade 10 education or equivalent.

What courses do you require to enter UBC in Sciences? At the grade 11 level, Chemistry 11, Physics 11, English 11 and Pre-Calculus 11.

Answers to these questions can also be found by googling the name of the post-secondary institution e.g. “BCIT” and “admissions”.

Students must have MYED access to enter their course selections and if they do not, they need to ask for MYED support in the office so that they can complete course planning.

We are requesting that students discuss course choices with parents/guardians and indicate parental approval in the “Notes for Counsellors” section in MYED.

Grade 8 Fine Arts/Applied Skills Rotations

As we approach Quarter 3, some students will be registered in courses that change half-way through the quarter. In Quarter 3, these will be courses in Dance, Drama, Foods, and Tech Ed. In Quarter 4, the courses will be Art, Drama, Foods, and Tech Ed. Here’s how to figure out where to go on the first day:

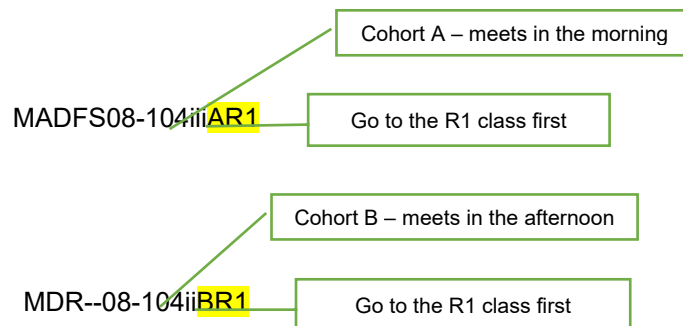
