### SCHOOL FEES 2019-20

#### 2019-20 General School Fees

The Vancouver School Board will continue its service of purchasing basic school supplies in bulk at wholesale prices and passing the cost savings on to families. The School Supply Fee for 2019-2020 will rise to \$35.00 per student.

This fee covers basic consumable school supplies used for students' personal use such as paper, writing tools, glue sticks, erasers, exercise books and art supplies. Supplies are provided for the full year.

Please remember that Maquinna charges a \$5 planner fee for most students and requests a \$15 performance fee from all students in addition to the \$35 general school fee, **for a total of \$55.**

Sometimes summer holiday plans extend into September. It is extremely important for the school to have an accurate number count of students at the beginning of the school year. If you are planning on returning to school after September 4, please fill out the attached form and return to the office before the end of the school year

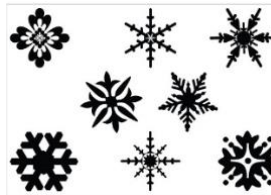

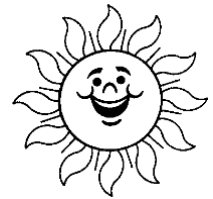

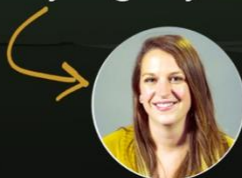
