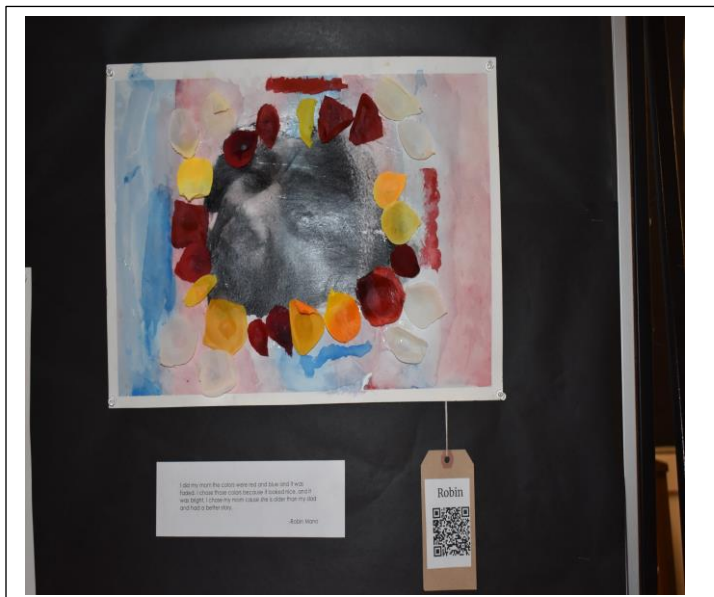
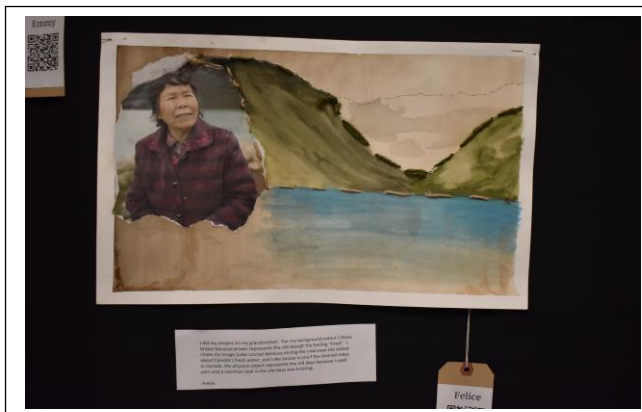
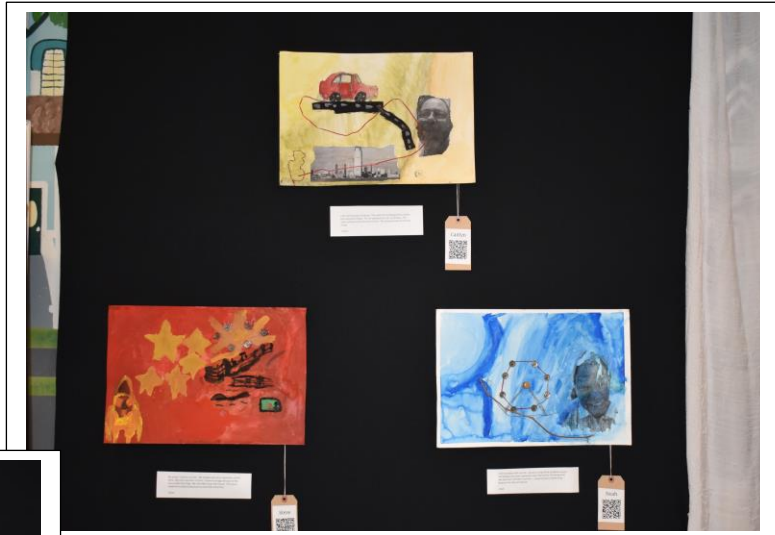
Arriving Late to School - you must sign your child in at the main office before heading to class.
