The students spent the past few weeks incorporating Musqueam teaching in their social studies unit. In this lesson, students explored the hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓ alphabet. Our conversations focused on the richness of language learning, and strategies and techniques used to revitalize a language.

Experiential learning! We received traditional harvesting practices, giving thanks, and taking only what we need before designing and measuring our materials. We followed a strict algorithm used by Ts'msyen weavers for generations when we used cedar imitation paper strips, but the students were encouraged to create their own weaving patterns this time around. They are still in progress. The cattails have been drying for months. Yesterday we reconstituted them by soaking them in water and had some fun 😊 just in time for Marin's farewell today.



Library News

The district has added many new Audiobooks and eBooks to the school library collection that can be enjoyed at home. Outside

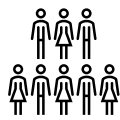
Our kind maintenance person answering the curious questions from this group of students as they look on while he is replacing the damaged bench. It's all done!
