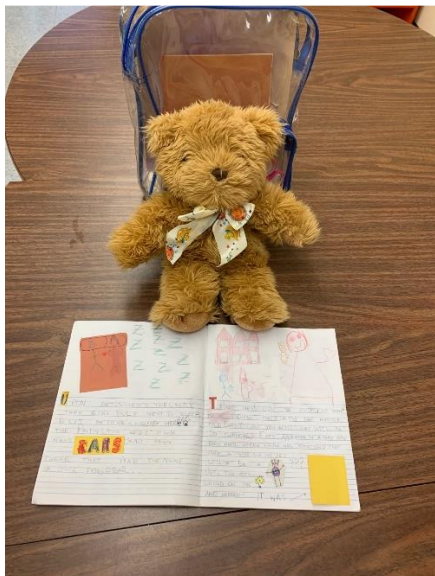
Our school is committed to supporting engaged learners, caring communities and an inclusive school environment.
