

Connecting to Staff




Mimi is one of our Supervision Aides who supports children when outside during breaks and sometimes in classrooms.




Visible Learning

The class also honoured Alex Trebek and played Jeopardy to see how their learning is going; with body systems, study of government and novel study.




Division 12 Ms. Hedley's class
