Vancouver School Board Personal Information and Media Consent

Consent for publicity through VSB online channels and publications

Schools and Districts are authorized to collect, use, and share student personal information that is directly related to and necessary for their educational functions. For other school or education-related purposes, parental or student consent is required. The Vancouver School Board is seeking your consent to collect, keep, use and share photographs, videos, images, and/or names of students to use on school or district website(s), district publications, e-newsletters, posters, social media sites and videos for education related purposes, such as recognizing and encouraging student achievement, building the school community and informing others about school and district programs and activities.

Consent for publicity through outside media outlets

Media (including radio, television, newspapers, and other print and online media) are sometimes permitted or invited to come to the school or to school activities and allowed to take photos or video or conduct interviews with students, for the purposes of promoting public understanding of school programs, building public support for public education and encouraging student achievement.....continued →

Consent for publicity through outside media outlets...continued

If you do not want your child to be involved in such activities, you need to:

- Tell your child to avoid these situations,
- Tell your child's teacher of your wishes,
- Complete and return this form to ask the school and school district to take reasonable steps to avoid this type of publication of your child's name, image, grade, or views by outside media.

Note that school and district staff cannot control news media access, photos/videos taken by the media or others in public locations (such as field trips or off school grounds) or school events open to the public, such as sports events, student performances, school board meetings, etc.
