#### Flexible Instructional Time (FIT)

Flexible Instructional Time (FIT) is instructional time available to all students two days a week for 50 minutes each day on Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons. This instructional time is designed to support students' personalized learning. The intent is to build-in flexibility and choice within a student's schedule that allows them to determine how, when and where their learning takes place, to access extra help from teachers, collaborate with peers and pursue other learning activities. During this time, all staff will be on site and students will be supported in determining how to use this flexible instructional time. Ultimately, FIT allows students to enjoy greater academic success by taking a more pro-active role in their learning.

#### **During FIT students are expected to:**

1. be in a designated learning space;
2. arrive in their FIT class on time and stay in the class for the whole period;
3. go to classrooms of teachers with whom they are presently enrolled;
4. complete past due work/tests, as requested by their teachers; or
5. work on school work (either individually or in groups), special interest (passion) projects, or silent reading during FIT.

#### **Students should not use FIT for:**

1. socializing;
2. using electronic devices for entertainment;
3. walking around the halls, visiting, going for a snack;
4. leaving the school for lunch, appointments, breaks, jobs;
5. going to unsupervised areas; or
6. regular classes, practices, rehearsals or club meetings.

FIT has been introduced at the start of the year with a series of lessons on time management, goal setting, self-awareness/self-regulation, and growth-mindset that will help students to productively use their time.
