The Valedictorian is a grade 12 student who gives the farewell address at the Graduation Ceremony on behalf of the graduating class. The Valedictorian reflects upon a theme relevant to their classmates and shares parting words of wisdom. The role of the Valedictorian carries with it great responsibility and great honour. The Valedictorian is respected by their peers and the staff and is a person who embodies the spirit of the graduating class.

The successful candidate will be selected based upon the following criteria:

- the student is in good standing and demonstrates good citizenship
- the student has a high academic standing (B or better)
- the student is to have good public speaking skills
- the student is to be representative of the school as shown by demonstrated excellence in a wide range of school activities including academics, extracurricular activities (music/drama/art/athletics/clubs and service/leadership)
- the student will have fulfilled the minimum requirements needed for graduation by June of 2022

Any student who is interested in representing the graduating class of 2022 in this manner is asked to submit an application package to Ms. Kwon by email to [bkwon@vsb.bc.ca](mailto:bkwon@vsb.bc.ca) by **Friday, April 8, 2022, 3:30 PM**. **Students must apply individually.** The application package must include:

- A list of five grade 12 students and one teacher, and their signatures who support your application. Use the space provided on this form.
- A statement of why you think you are a good candidate for Class Valedictorian based on criteria listed above (max. 200 words). Use only the space provided on this form.
- A draft of a complete speech. The draft should be typed and attached to this form. Applications without a complete speech will not be considered.
