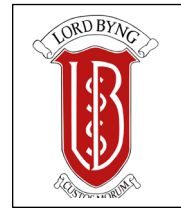


# Covid -19 Work Experience PERMISSION FORM



In light of the changing nature of our Work Experience workplaces and the potential risk that students could be facing due to Covid-19 exposure during their Work Experience placements, we have been asked to ensure that parental/guardian permission still exist for the student's placement.

Three important reminders:

1. Workers in B.C. have the right to refuse work if they believe it presents an undue hazard.
2. WorkSafeBC is advising employers and workers to follow the recommended personal hygiene practices like frequent hand washing, avoiding touching your face, and avoiding direct contact with others.
3. If COVID vaccine passports are a requirement of all workers at a work site/placement employer, then students doing the work experience need to comply.
