

Dogwood Diploma - at a glance:

The B.C. Certificate of Graduation or "Dogwood Diploma" is awarded to students who successfully complete the provincial graduation requirements.

Students require a minimum of 80 credits of Grade 10, 11, & 12 courses to graduate.

Of these 80 credits:

- At least 16 credits must be at the Grade 12 level, including a required Language Arts 12
- At least 28 credits must be elective course credits
- 52 credits are required from the following:
 - Career-Life Education (4 credits), and Career-Life Connections (4 credits) =8
 - Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits) =4
 - Science 10 (4 credits), and a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits) =8
 - Social Studies 10 (4 credits), and a Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits) =8
 - A Math 10 (4 credits), and a Math 11 or 12 (4 credits) =8
 - A Language Arts 10, 11 and a required 12 (12 credits total) =12
 - An Arts Education 10, 11, or 12 and/or an Applied Design, Skills, and Technologies 10, 11, or 12 (4 credits total) =4

In addition, students must also complete three new graduation assessments:

The Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment was introduced in 2018

The Grade 10 Literacy Assessment was introduced in 2019/20

The Grade 12 Literacy Assessment will be introduced in 2020/21
