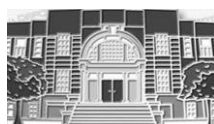
On another note, please be advised that for safety reasons, classroom doors are kept locked at all times.

Basketball

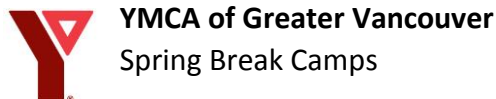
