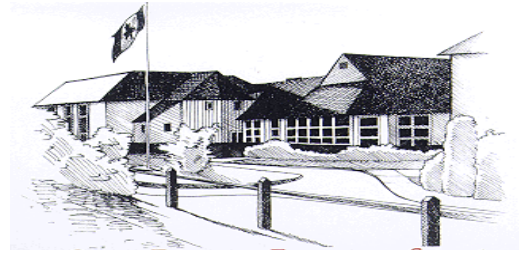

Report Cards



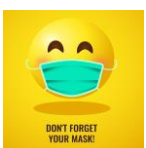
