Quarter 4 Schedule Changes

The District will safely increase in-person learning for students by making the following adjustments:

- Maximize the amount of in-person learning time to two hours and 45 minutes every day for all grade 8 and 9 courses
- Increase in-person learning time for students in grades 10 through 12 courses to two hours and 45 minutes two days per week, and one hour and 45 minutes, three days per week
- Allow any student wanting to attend school all day, to do so
- Continue to work collaboratively with families to support those students struggling with their overall mental well-being

To implement these changes at Windermere, the following adjustments will be made:

- change to daily schedule

- teachers will assign students to a flex block to attend for in-person remote learning in most instances, students will be assigned to a flex class that lines up with their in-person class
- students will be informed by their teacher on April 16
