IT STARTS WITH GRADUATION.

This \$1000 award is an initiative of the BC Ministry of Education and honours the achievement of students pursuing an apprenticeship.

The first requirement is that you must graduate to qualify.

900 HOURS OF APPRENTICESHIP

It is your responsibility to work with your employer to ensure that your apprenticeship hours are reported to the ITA.

Contact your Career Programs teacher when you reach **480 hours** and again when you complete **900 hours**.

YOUR GRADES MATTER!

To earn the award, you need have an average of **72% (or higher)** in all grade 12 courses.

We suggest setting a personal goal to earn at least 72% in all grade 12 courses to give focus to your learning plans as they move from school to work.

WHAT'S THE DEADLINE?

The requirements described above must be completed before **December 31st** of the school year when you turn 19.

This is a firm deadline, so we strongly encourage you to keep in contact with your Career Programs teacher and employer about your apprenticeship hours.
